

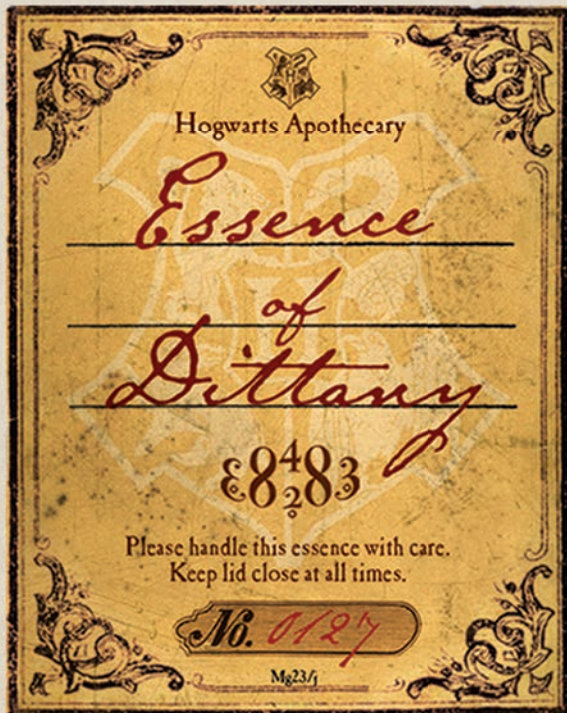

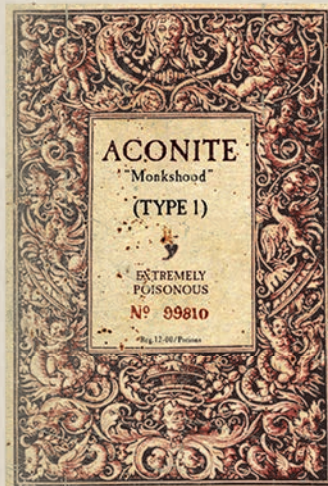

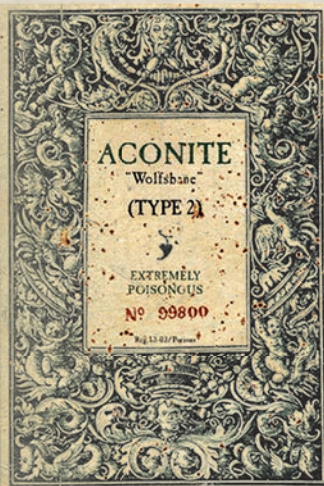

A bezoar is a stone taken from the stomach of a goat that acts as an antidote against most poisons; it was used by Harry Potter to save Ron Weasley from poisoned mead in *Harry Potter and the Half-Blood Prince*. 2. **CONCOCTION NO. 460** label from the Hogwarts Apothecary Department seen throughout the films. 3. **ESSENCE OF DITTANY** label for a restorative potion used by Hermione Granger to heal Ron's arm when he is splinched in *Harry Potter and the Deathly Hallows – Part 1*. 4.
