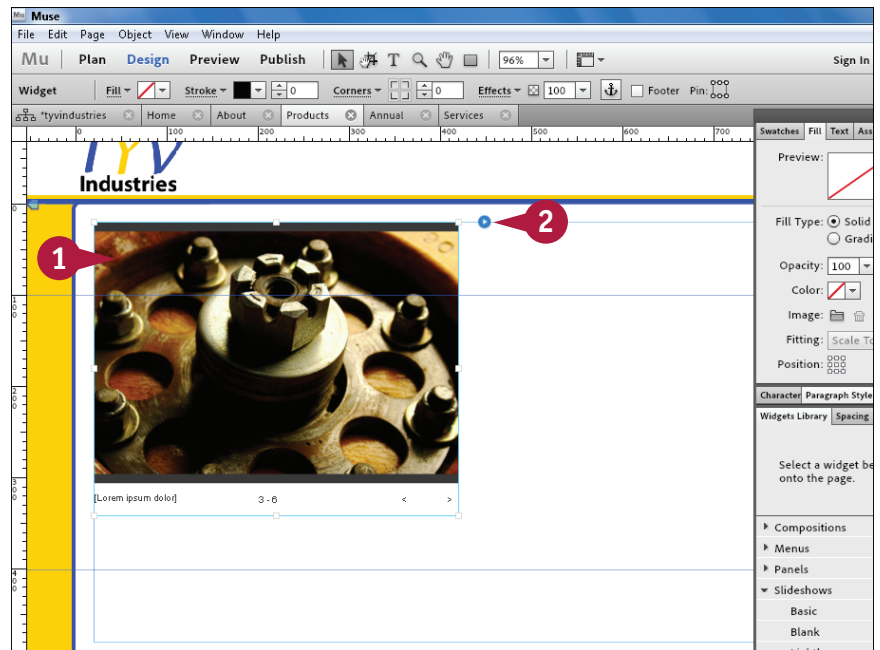


Configure the Slideshow

The Slideshow widgets have a large set of configuration options. You can set the type of transition, turn on auto play, and set the alignment of the Hero image and thumbnail. You can add additional parts such as navigation buttons, captions, a counter, and thumbnails. Finally, you can choose whether to show the lightbox parts, such as the fill color, and choose whether or not to edit all the slides on the widget together. All these options can be accessed by clicking the editing options icon.

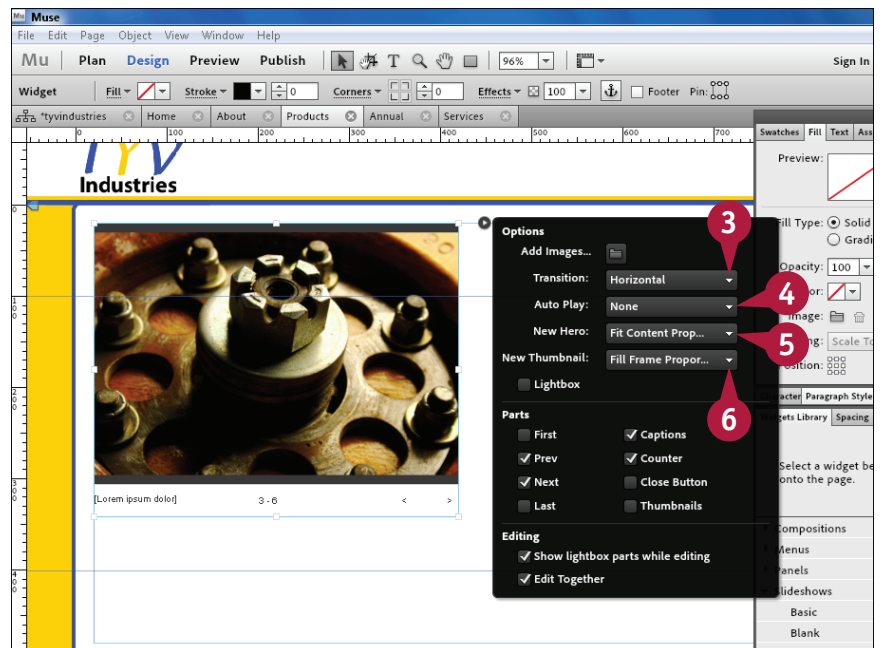
Configure the Slideshow

- 1 Click the Slideshow widget.
- 2 Click the editing options icon (⚙️).

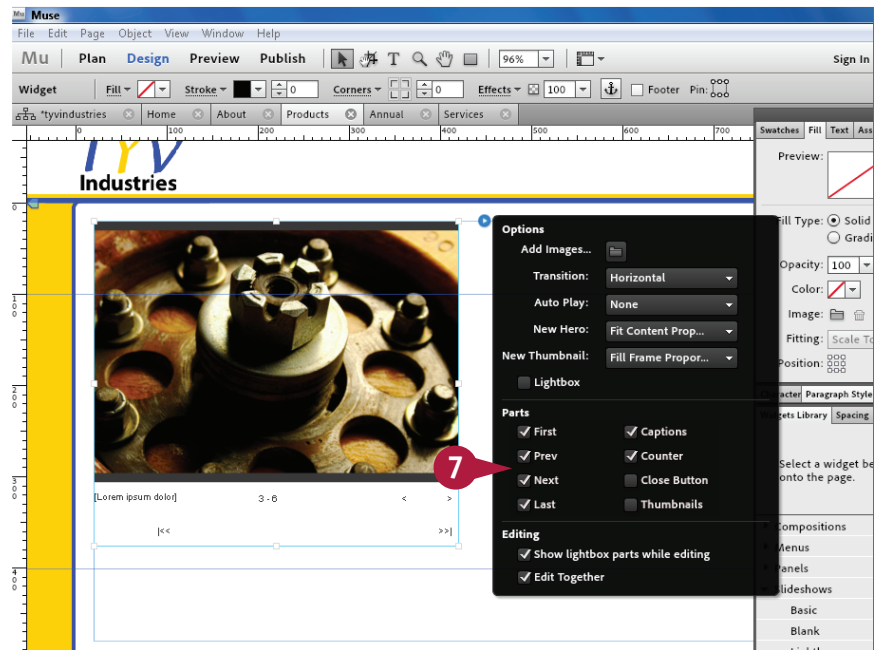


The Options menu appears.

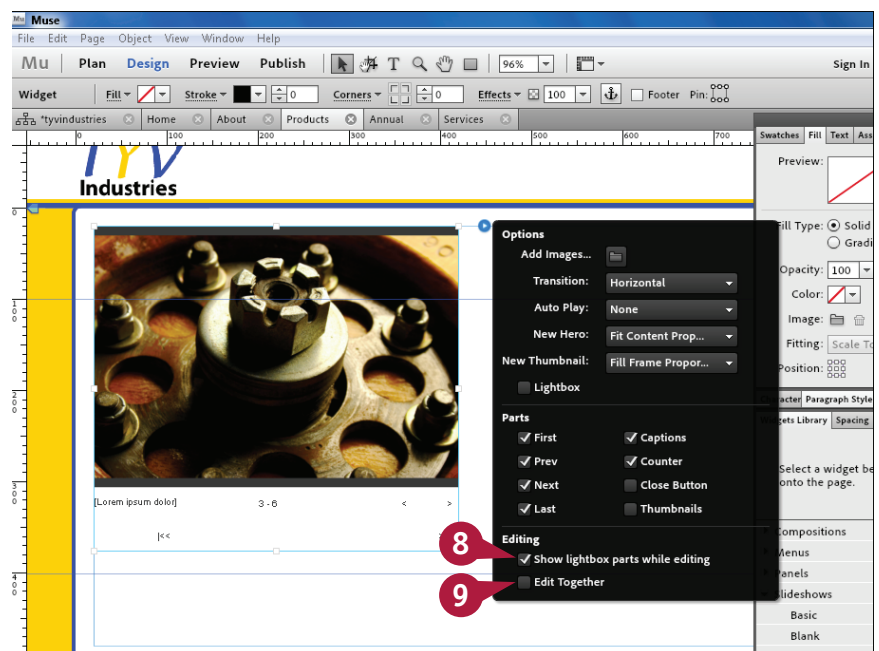
- 3 Set a transition.
- 4 Set a desired auto play option.
- 5 Set a desired alignment for new images.
- 6 Set a desired alignment for new thumbnails.



- 7 If desired, show additional parts (■ changes to)



- 8 Select whether to show or hide the lightbox parts (■ changes to)
 - 9 Select whether to edit the slides together (■ changes to)
- The widget is configured.



TIP

If I choose to add thumbnails, will I have to create them all individually as I did with the Composition widgets?

No. The Composition widgets are designed to allow you to use many different types of content, and so do not create thumbnails automatically because it would be impossible to know what the thumbnail should display. The Slideshow widgets, on the other hand, are built specifically to work with images, so if you turn on the Thumbnails option, smaller versions of each slide are created for you.
