

# Shipping Requirements: Small Parcel



## Box type

- Regular slotted carton (RSC)
- B flute
- ECT-32 (edge crush test)
- 200 lb/square inch (PSI) burst strength

## Box dimensions

- Boxes containing multiple standard-size items do not exceed 25" on any side

## Box contents

- All boxes contain inventory associated with the same shipment ID only
- Shipment details and items in the box are the same:
  - Merchant SKU
  - FNSKU
  - Condition
  - Quantity
  - Packing option (individual or case-packed)

## Box weight

- Boxes containing jewelry or watches weigh 40 lb or less
- Boxes containing multiple items weigh 50 lb or less (Single oversize items in boxes may exceed 50 lb)
- Boxes containing a single oversize item that weighs more than 50 lb have "Team Lift" safety labels affixed to the top and sides of the box
- Boxes containing a single oversize item that weighs more than 100 lb have "Mechanical Lift" safety labels affixed to the top and sides of the box

## Combined boxes

- Boxes are not bundled (no bagging, taping, elastic, or extra straps)
- Point-of-sale containers are packed in approved boxes (see Box types)

## Dunnage

- Bubble wrap
- Foam
- Air pillows
- Full sheets of paper

# Shipping Requirements: Small Parcel

## Shipment Labels

- Two (2) labels per box: one FBA label and one carrier label
- Place labels:
  - On the side no less than 1¼" from the edge of the box
  - Away from box seams, edges, or corners
- Labels must include:
  - Shipment ID
  - Scannable barcode label
  - Ship-from address
  - Ship-to address

## Case-packed boxes

- All cases have been previously packaged together by the manufacturer
- All items in the case have matching merchant SKUs (MSKUs) and are in the same condition
- All cases contain equal quantities
- Manufacturer barcodes on the case have been removed or covered
- Master cartons are split at the appropriate case-pack level
