A Amber Light

You should be very aware of flashing amber traffic lights. It means cars should wait for pedestrians to cross the road, but they may not have seen you, so make sure you wait for the green man.

B Bus



C Cyclist

It's not just cars you should be careful of on the road; cyclists can go very fast so check for those too when crossing the road.

D Dog



E Eight Letterboxes

Can you find eight letterboxes?

F Flowers

Can you see any flowers nearby, in a garden or park?

G Green Man

The green man is your best friend on the way to and from school; you should be able to find lots of them on both journeys.

H House

Get 2 x ticks if you can spot a house with a red door.

I Island (Island in Road)

When there are no pedestrian or zebra crossings on the road you need to cross, there may be a road island nearby.

J Jogger



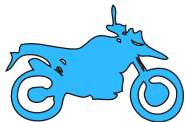
K Kerb

Make sure you stay back from the kerb and out of the road!

L Lollipop Lady

Get 2 x ticks in your box if you say 'thank you' to the Lollipop lady/man.

N Numberplate

If you spot a really new car with a number plate that has the number 11 near the beginning, give yourself 2 ticks!

O Older People

You may come across older people on your way to and from school. If you walk faster than them, take care when you pass.

P Pelican Crossing

A pelican crossing is a crossing with a red and green man. Get 2 x ticks if you can name three other animals beginning with P.

Q Queue



R Roundabout

Roundabouts can be confusing places with lots of cars wanting to go different ways. Always remember to look out, use the 'Green Cross Code' and cross one road at a time, **never** go across the roundabout.

S Street Light



T Traffic Lights

Some pedestrian crossings have a red and a green man. Press the button and wait for the green man to show and the traffic to stop before you cross.

U Umbrella



V Van

If you spot a red Royal Mail van award yourself 2 x ticks.

W Walkers

Can you see anyone else walking? If you see a friend walking, give them a wave!

X Crossroads

Crossroad junctions are often shaped like an 'X'. Make sure you take care and cross one road at a time.

Y Yellow Car



Z Zig Zags

Can you see any zig zags painted on the road? You often see them outside the school gates. They mean cars can't stop on them.
