



iCurve Quick Start Guide

CONGRATULATIONS ON YOUR PURCHASE OF iCURVE

Check to make sure the box contains these included components:

- iCurve – Invisible Laptop Stand
- Bag of extra pads including:
 - four non-slip base pads
 - two **optional** arm bumper pads - (**tip** - try using iCurve without these first)

SETTING UP iCURVE

Using iCurve is very straightforward. Simply place your notebook on top of iCurve's arms. The best placement is usually with the notebook screen even with the back of the iCurve. It is OK if the notebook extends past the ends of the arms in front. The notebook is held by the friction pads underneath and most of the weight is concentrated near the back. Attach any external keyboard and mouse and your laptop now has become a comfortable desktop machine.

USING iCURVE

You may utilize iCurve's base to rotate or reposition your laptop just as you would adjust a monitor's position. You can also use this mobility to move your laptop out of the way when it's not in use. The desk space left inside the bend of the iCurve can also be used as a convenient place for external peripherals like external hard drives or CD-Rom drives.

USING OPTIONAL PADS

Included with your iCurve are six optional pads. The round base pads may be attached to the base to prevent any sliding or movement. The two arm bumper pads may be attached to the ends of the iCurve's arms to hold odd shaped or older-heavier laptops. We recommend you try using the iCurve **WITHOUT** these pads first. Most laptops are very secure without them.
