## Limited Two Year Warranty

Genesis Power Tools are warranted free from defects in material and workmanship for (2) two years after date of the original purchase. This Limited Warranty does not cover normal wear and tear or damage from neglect or accident. The original purchaser is covered by this warranty and it is not transferable. Genesis NiCad and Lithium-Ion Batteries are warranted for (1) one year.

Accessories are not covered by the Two Year Warranty.
