

## Warranty Info

### KEGCO LIMITED ONE YEAR WARRANTY ON WINE CELLAR REFRIGERATORS:

For one year from the date of purchase by the original owner, Kegco will repair or replace any part of the unit which proves to be defective in materials or workmanship under normal use. During this period, Kegco will provide all the parts and labor necessary to correct such defects free of charge as long as the unit has been installed and operated in accordance with the written instructions in our owners manuals. If the unit is deemed non-repairable by an Kegco authorized service center, Kegco will provide you with a reasonably similar replacement product that is either new or factory refurbished. In rental or commercial use, the warranty period is only 90 days from the original date of purchase. All Kegco appliances of 3.5 cubic feet capacity or less must be brought to an authorized Kegco service center for repairs.

### LIMITED SECOND THROUGH FIFTH YEAR WARRANTY:

For the second through fifth year from the original date of purchase, Kegco will provide a replacement compressor free of charge due to a failure. You are responsible for the service, labor and freight charges. In rental or commercial use, the limited compressor warranty is one year and nine months. Cost to move the appliance to the service center and back to the user's home will be the user's responsibility and will not be covered by Kegco.

### WHAT IS NOT COVERED:

1. Content loss of food or other due to spoilage.
2. Incidental or consequential damages.
3. Parts and labor costs for the following will not be under warranty:
  1. Light blubs and/or plastic housing
  2. Plastic cabinet liners
  3. Punctured evaporator that voids the warranty on the complete sealed system
  4. Repairs performed by unauthorized service providers
  5. Service calls that do not involve defects in the material or workmanship such as customer education, door reversal, or proper installation.
  6. Surcharges including, but not limited to any after hour, weekend, or holiday service calls, tolls, ferry trip charges, or mileage expenses for service calls to remote areas, including the state of Alaska.
  7. Service calls that are related to external problems such as but not limited to: abuse, misuse, inadequate electrical power and accidents.
4. Fire, flood or acts of God
5. Replacement of house fuses or resetting of circuit breakers.
6. Failure of the product if it is used for an operation it is not intended for.
7. This warranty is void outside of the Continental United States.

Manufacturers' warranties may not apply in all cases, depending on factors such as use of the product, where the product was purchased, or who you purchased the product from. Please review the warranty carefully, and contact the manufacturer if you have any questions.
