The Warranty Period is one year from the date of shipment for mini-DPF, Photo Alarm Clock, and HomeSpot product lines.

To make a warranty claim please contact your sales representative at GT-tronics within the Warranty Period and provide order number and product name. You may return the product to designated service depot at your cost, after first obtaining a Return Material Authorization (RMA) number and following any other guidelines specified.

GT-tronics may at its option repair this product or provide you with an equivalent product; and if unable to repair or replace the product, will settle in monetary terms to the maximum the product's purchase price.
