

The following instructions will help you turn on the Wi-Fi of your Archos 5 with Android device, get connected to a wireless network and go on the Internet.



Step 1 - Turn on Wi-Fi:

1. Starting at the "Home Screen", select the Menu icon, at the upper right corner of the unit.
2. Once selected, a secondary menu appears at the bottom of the screen, please select "**Settings**", on the right side of this menu.
3. This will bring you to the Settings menu. Select "**Wireless Controls**" and make sure Wi-Fi is turned on (green mark). If it is not, double click on "**Wi-Fi**" to turn it on.

Step 2 - Select Wi-Fi network:

1. In the Wireless Controls menu select "**Wi-Fi settings**" which takes you to the next screen.
2. Select the Menu icon in the upper right side of screen and click on "**Scan**"
3. Once the scan is complete, then simply select the appropriate Network. If Network is protected, enter the correct WEP key (click on text box to bring up the keyboard) and select "**Connect**".
4. Once device is ready the Wi-Fi Networks will say "Connected" underneath the selected network.

Step 3 - Open the web browser:

1. From the home Screen select the "**Browser**" icon
2. Once the web browser is open, click on the Menu icon in the upper right side of screen
3. Select "**Go to**" if you want to enter a URL address
4. Select "**Favorites**" if you want to try some of the pre selected sites
