



BT-1 RUN HEADSET

USER MANUAL

Thank you for choosing the iblast audio BT1-RUN wireless headset. The BT1-RUN uses Bluetooth 4.1 with noise elimination technology, to provide superior sound quality, better battery life and easy hands-free operation.

Product Overview



Function	Operation
Power On	Long press MFB for 3 seconds
Power Off	Long press MFB for 3.5 seconds
Pairing Mode	While off, long press MFB for 6.5 seconds
Answer Call	Short press MFB once
End Call	Short press MFB once
Reject / Ignore Call	Long press MFB for 1 second
Redial Last Number	Double press MFB
Cancel/End	Short press MFB once
Pause, Play	Short press MFB
Vol+ / Vol- (BACK/FWD)	Short/Long press Vol- / Vol+ (BACK/FWD)

Charging

- Connect Micro USB to any USB charger, 2 hours to charge.
- For best wireless performance perform a full charge.

Volume Button

- Volume + / - (controls volume level)

LED

- While usb is connected: Red light indicates charging, Blue light indicates full charge.
- Red light flashing twice indicates low battery. (low battery voice prompt)

Steps to Connect Bluetooth Headset

1. When headset is turned off, long press the MFB (6 seconds), until the headset LED is flashing red and blue (pairing state voice prompt) headset is now in pairing state.
2. Turn on the mobile phone bluetooth, press scan, wait until bluetooth displays "iblast audio RUN".
3. Click the headset model to connect. After the connection is successful. The headphone's blue light will flash.
4. Enter Password "0000" if your mobile phone needs you to enter a password.

Your headset should now be paired.

Multi-Point Function Steps

1. Turn off bluetooth from mobile phone or other device that is already paired then repeat steps 1-4 for 2nd bluetooth device.
2. Turn on mobile phone #1's Bluetooth function and find the wireless headset, click connect to activate multipoint.

Reconnecting the Headset:

- Headset will try to reconnect automatically.
- If your headset does not try to reconnect, please press the MFB one time and go to your phone's Bluetooth menu to reconnect manually.

Restore Factory Settings

- Hold the MFB for 3 seconds while charging, until the red and blue lights flash three times to restore factory settings.

Troubleshooting

Mobile phone can't find headset

Solutions:

1. Confirm if the headset is turned on. (Whether the LED indicator light is on or Red and Blue lights are flashing)
2. If the headset is turned on but it still cannot be found, please restart your mobile phone and the headset.

After connecting the headset with your mobile phone, there is always static noise or it disconnects.

Important Please Note: Cross-body interference Bluetooth's radio frequency is blocked by water, the human body is made up of mostly water.

If you keep your cell phone in your left pocket then it is possible that the connection may be weak, which can cause some interference issues.

Solutions:

1. The wireless headset's battery is low, charge the headset.
2. Trying holding your phone in your hand or placing it in your right pocket. If you wear an armband try placing it on your right arm.

Max distance between wireless headset and mobile phone or other Bluetooth device

The max distance between headset and device is 10 meters in clear line of sight. If you exceed the max distance, or if too many things are blocking the clear line of sight, the signal may fade and cause other connectivity issues.

The red light is not on while charging

Possible reason: It has been a long time since last charging the headset.

Solution: Headset needs to charge about 30 minutes, then the red light should light up.

Note: Overcharging or keeping the wireless headset in a closed car or similar high heat environment for long periods of time will reduce the capacity and life of the battery.
