WARNING

- * Failure to follow these warnings and assembly instructions could result in serious injury or death.
- * Read all instructions before assembling crib. **KEEP INSTRUCTIONS FOR FUTURE USE.**
- * Check this product for damaged hardware, loose joints, loose bolts or other fasteners, missing parts or sharp edges before assembly and frequently during use. Securely tighten loose bolts and other fasteners. **DO NOT** use crib if any parts are missing, damaged or broken. Contact a customer service representative at 1-800-295-1980 for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. **DO NOT** substitute parts.
- * Infants can suffocate on soft bedding. Never add a pillow or comforter. Never place additional padding under an infant.
- * Stop using the crib when child begins to climb out or reaches the height of 35 inches (89 cm).
- * To reduce the risk of SIDS, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.
- * **DO NOT** place crib near window where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.
- * Strings can cause strangulation! **DO NOT** place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. **DO NOT** suspend strings over a crib or attach strings to toys.
- * To help prevent strangulation tighten all fasteners. A child can trap parts of the body or clothing on loose fasteners.
- * If refinishing, use a non-toxic finish specified for children's products.
- * When child is able to pull to standing position, set mattress to lowest position and remove bumper pads, large toys and other objects that could serve as steps for climbing out.
- * Never use plastic shipping bags or other plastic film as mattress covers because they can cause suffocation.
- * Replace teething rail if damaged or loose (if teething rail is provided for this model).
- * **CAUTION: ANY MATTRESS USED IN THIS CRIB MUST BE AT LEAST 27-1/4 INCHES BY 51-5/8 INCHES (69CM BY 131CM) WITH A THICKNESS NOT EXCEEDING 6 INCHES (15CM).**
- * Infants can suffocate in gaps between crib sides and a mattress that is too small.
- * The **TODDLER BED** or **DAY BED** is not intended for children under 15 months of age or over 50 pounds (22.7kgs).
- * If guardrails are used as the mattress containment means, guardrail(s) provided must be used to avoid the formation of a gap between the mattress and the bed that could cause an entrapment (when product is used as a **TODDLER BED** or **DAY BED**).
- * **CAUTION: ENTRAPMENT HAZARD.** To avoid dangerous gaps, any mattress used on this bed shall be a full-size crib mattress at least 51-5/8 inches (1310 mm) in length, 27-1/4 inches (690 mm) in width, and a max thickness of 6 inches (150 mm).
- * Follow warnings on all products in a crib.

NOTES

- * Ensure all parts and components are present before beginning assembly.
- * Assemble on a soft, smooth surface to prevent damage to product finish.
- * Phillips head screw driver is not included.
- * **DO NOT** use power tools.
- * CAUTIONS: Adult assembly required.
- * Assembly will require two people.
- * Estimated assembly time: 30 minutes.

CARE AND CLEANING

Dust regularly with a soft, lint-free cloth to prevent soil build-up. A damp cloth may be used occasionally to clean surface. Dry immediately. Do not use any abrasives that may damage finish. Excessive exposure to sunlight and extreme changes in temperature and moisture can damage wood furniture.

MAINTENANCE

Check bolts/screws periodically and tighten them if necessary.

LIMITED WARRANTY

DOREL ASIA warrants its product to be free from defects in material and workmanship and agrees to remedy any such defect. This warranty covers 1 year from the date of original purchase. This warranty is valid only upon presentation of proof of purchase. This is solely limited to the repair or replacement of defective furniture components and no assembly labor is included. 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STEP 1:

Insert the wood dowels (1) into the back panel (C).

Attach the left and right posts (A & B) to the back panel (C) with hex socket head bolts (2) and spring washers (6) as shown. First put the spring washers (6) in the hole, second insert the hex socket head bolts (2) then tighten the bolts with allen key (4).



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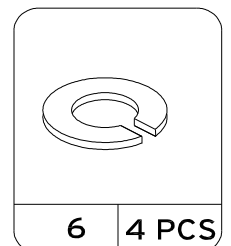
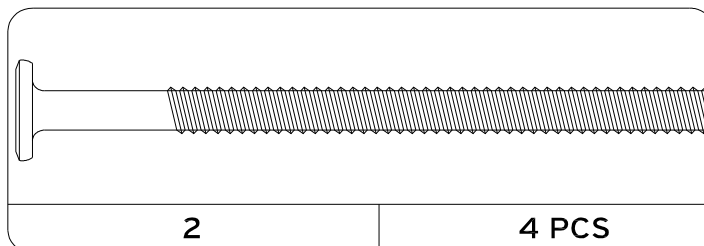
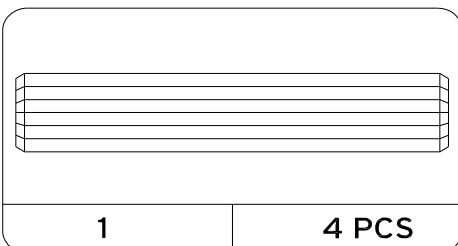
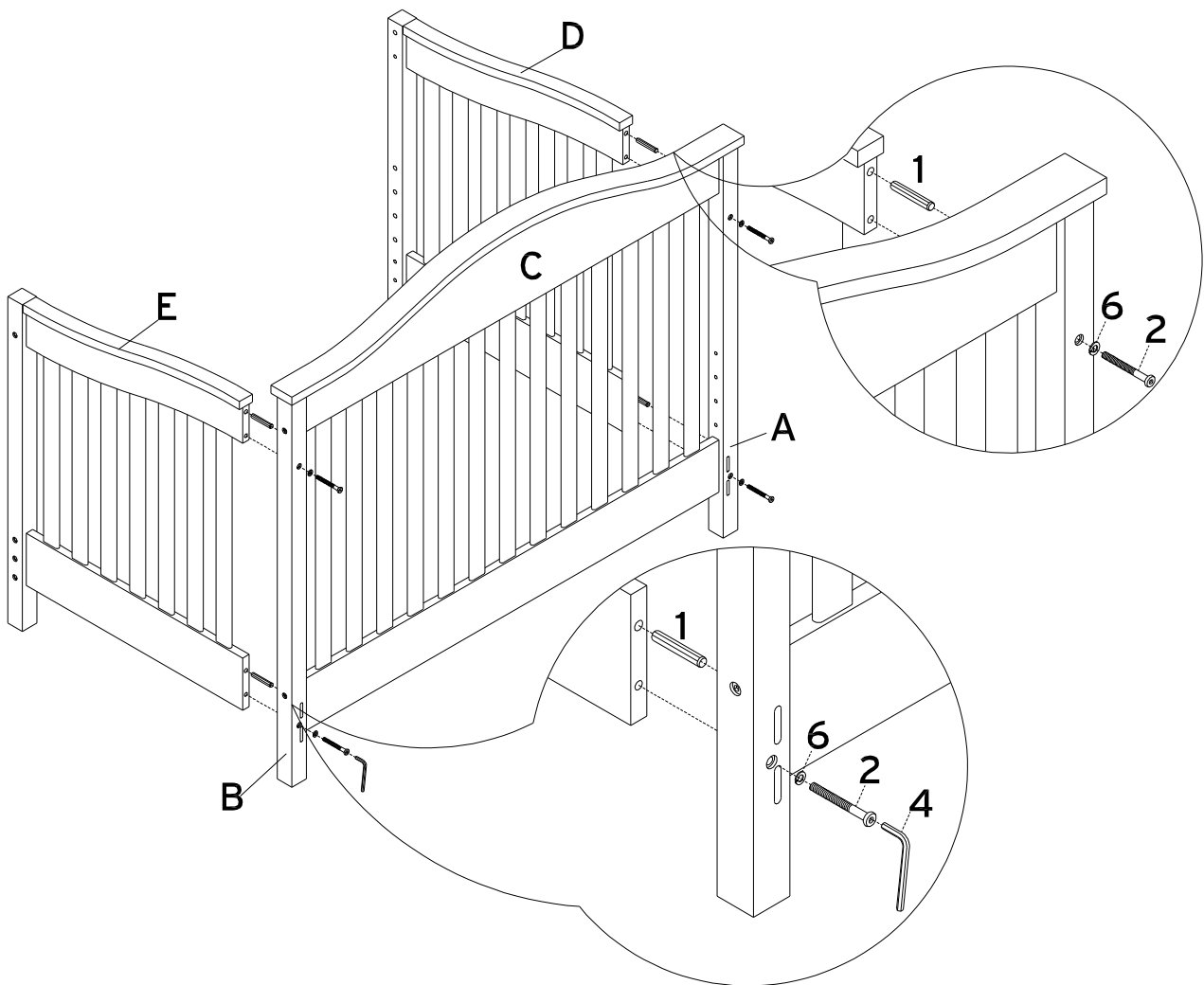
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STEP 2:

Insert wood dowels (1) into the left side panel (D).

Attach the left side panel (D) to the left post (A) with hex socket head bolts (2) and spring washers (6) as shown. First put the spring washers (6) in the hole, second insert the hex socket head bolts (2) then tighten the bolts with allen key (4).

Repeat this step to attach the right side panel (E) to right post (B) as shown.

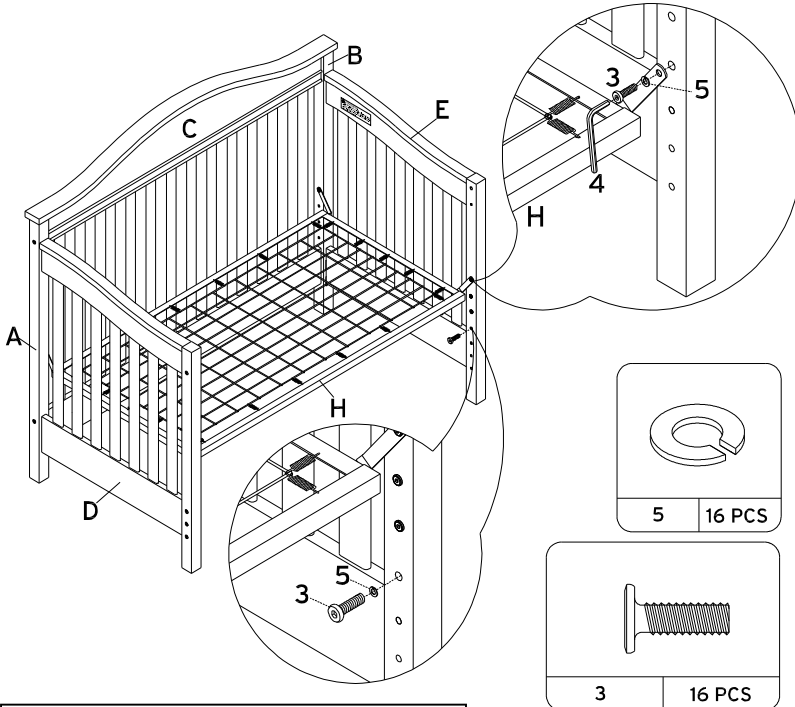

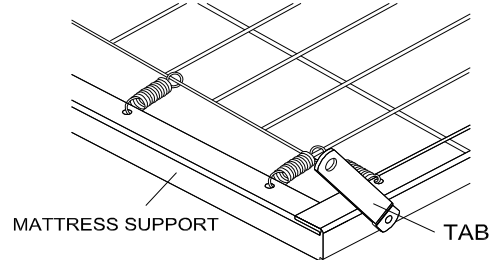
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STEP 3:

Attach the mattress support (H) to the left and right side panels (D & E) and the posts (A & B) with mattress support bolts (3) and spring washers (5). Use Allen key (4) to tighten the bolts.



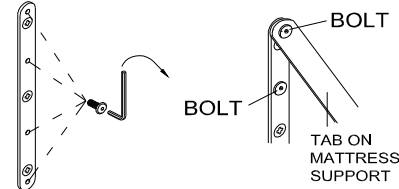
DETAIL 1



NOTE: Tabs must always be above the mattress support when installed as shown in detail 1. Do not install the mattress support up side down where the 4 edges are above the wire mesh.

DETAIL 2

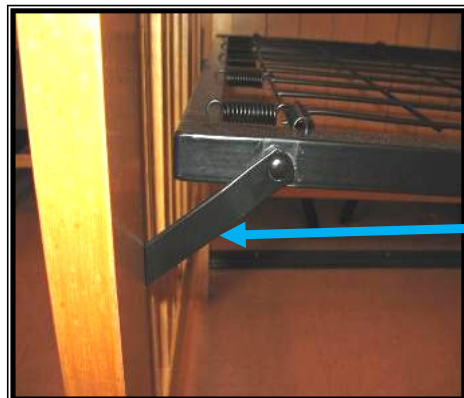
4 POSITION HOLES FOR MATTRESS SUPPORT



NOTE: Please ensure that all the height adjustment holes are filled with appropriate bolts after the mattress support has been moved to the desired level. Make sure that these bolts are tightly secured.



✗ INCORRECT-
Raised edge should face down - this photo shows mattress support is upside down.



✗ INCORRECT-
Tabs on corners of mattress support should point up.



CORRECT ✓

* Tabs to point UP.

* Flat surface of mattress support to face up - mattress must sit on flat surface.

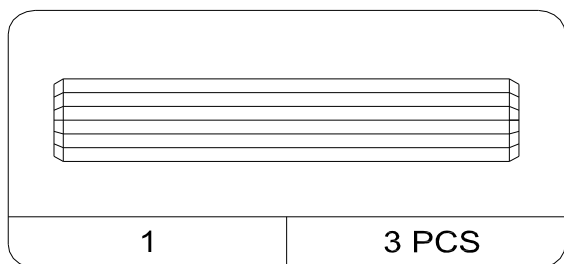
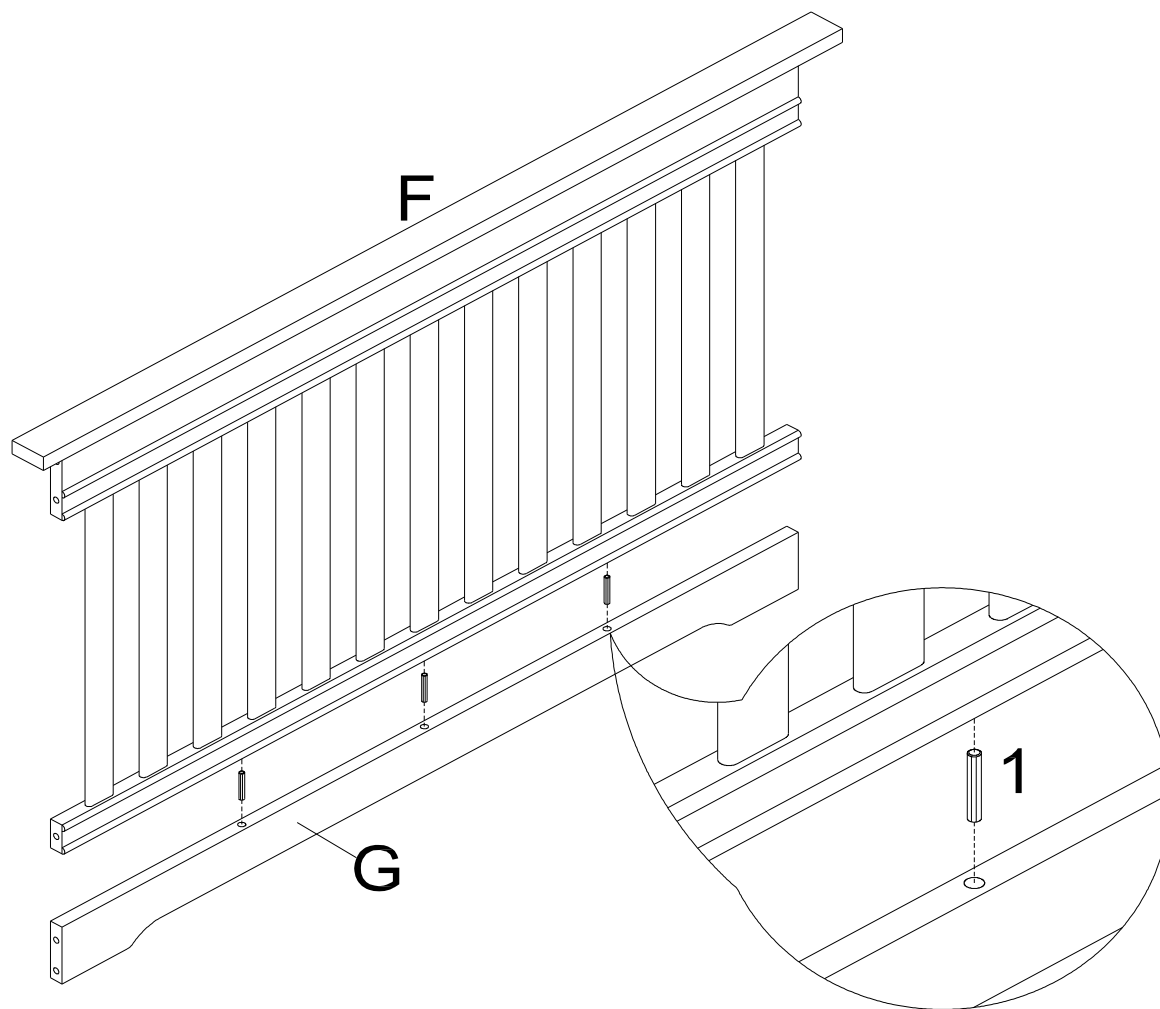
NOTE: The above photos and drawings showing how to properly attach the mattress support are for reference only. Crib styles and colors will vary.

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STEP 4:

Attach the front rail (G) to the front panel (F) with wood dowels (1) as shown.
Note: The curved edge of front rail (G) must face towards the ground.



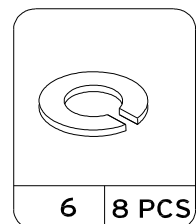
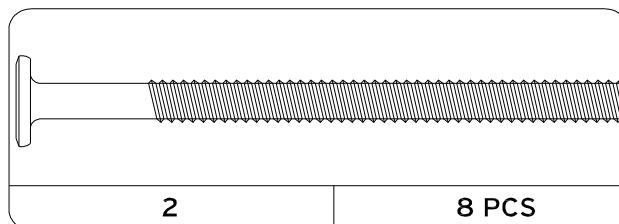
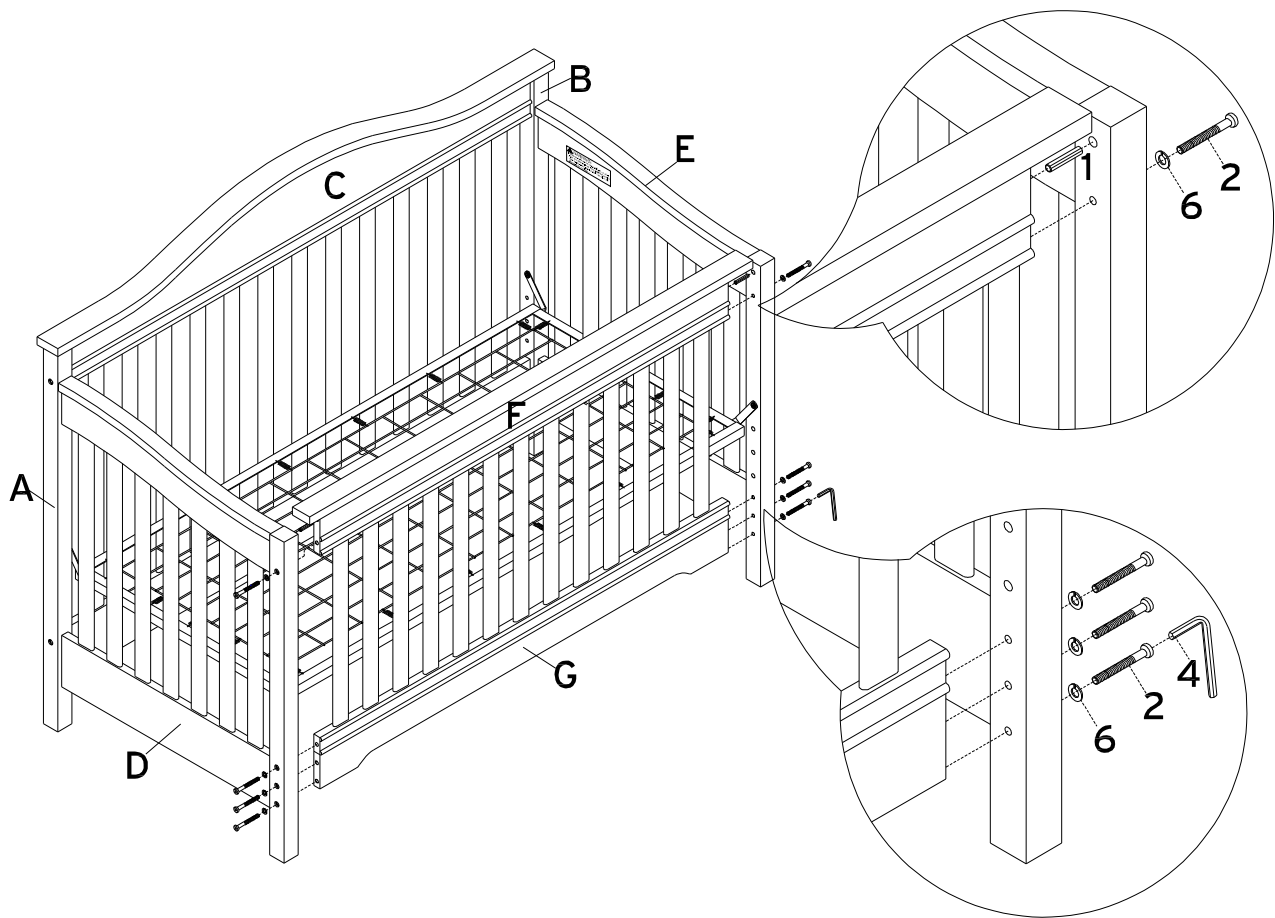
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STEP 5:

Attach the assembled front panel (done in step 4) to left and right side panels (D & E) with wood dowels (1), hex socket head bolts (2) and spring washers (6) as shown. First put the spring washers (6) in the hole, second insert the hex socket head bolts (2) then tighten the bolts with allen key (4).

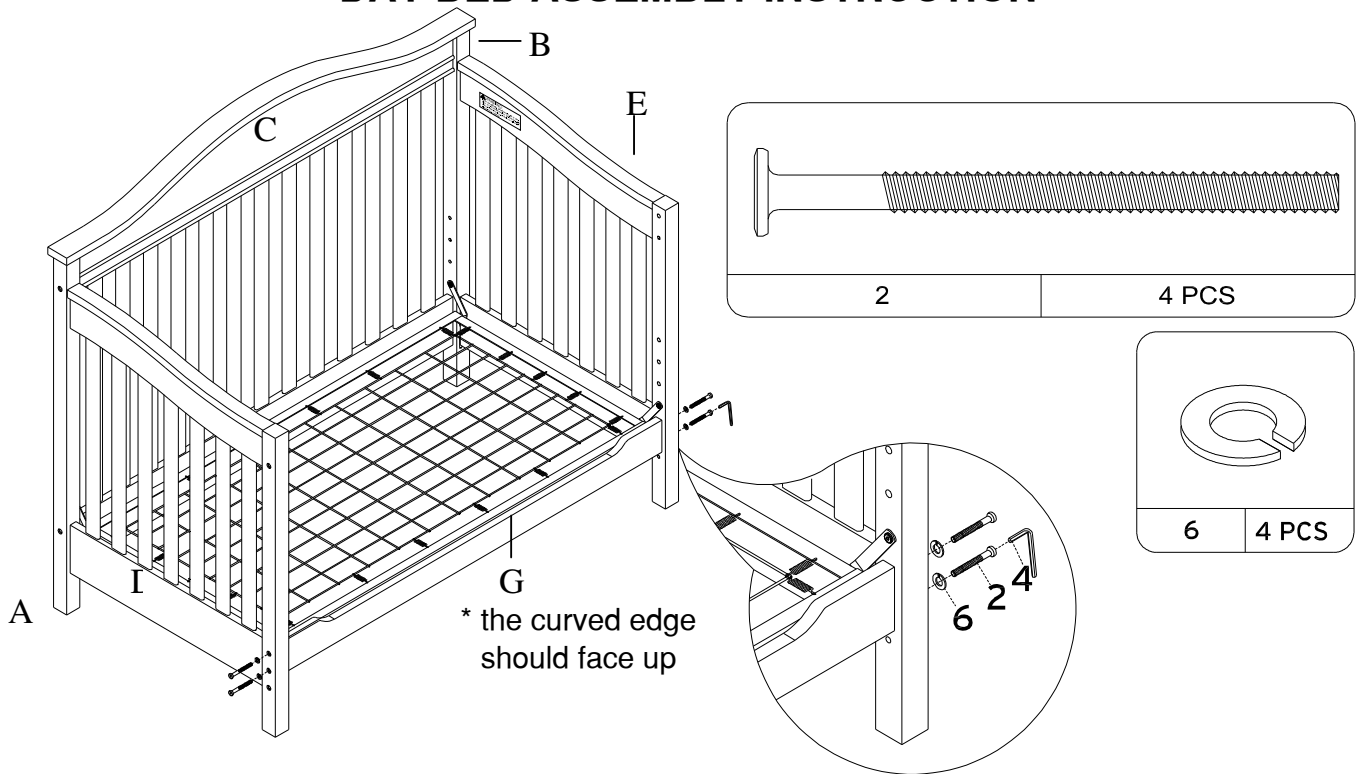
NOTE: When the child is able to stand on his/her own, place the mattress support at its lowest position.



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DAY BED ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION



WARNINGS:

- * Any mattress used in this crib must be at least 27-1/4 inches by 51-5/8 inches (69cm by 131cm) with a thickness not exceeding 6 inches (15cm).
- * The day bed is not intended for children under 15 months of age or over 50 pounds (22.7 kgs).

NOTE: When inserting bolts, turn clockwise until tighten. Then loosen 1/2-3/4 of a turn. After crib is completely assembled, return to each bolt and tighten. Use wax or soap on all bolts to facilitate assembly.

DAY BED ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION: STARTING FROM CRIB

- STEP 1:** Detach the assembled front panel (F & G) from the side panels (D & E) with Allen Key (4).
- STEP 2:** Move the mattress support (H) to the lowest position by unscrewing bolts (3) with Allen Key (4).
- STEP 3:** Attach the front rail (G) (the curved edge should face up) to the side panels (D & E) with bolts (2), spring washers (6) and Allen Key (4). First put the spring washers (6) in the hole, second insert the hex socket head bolts (2) then tighten the bolts with allen key (4).

DAY BED ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION: STARTING FROM SCRATCH

- STEP 1:** Follow steps 1 to 3 of the crib assembly instruction.
- STEP 2:** Follow steps 2 to 3 for the day bed assembly instruction located above (starting from crib).

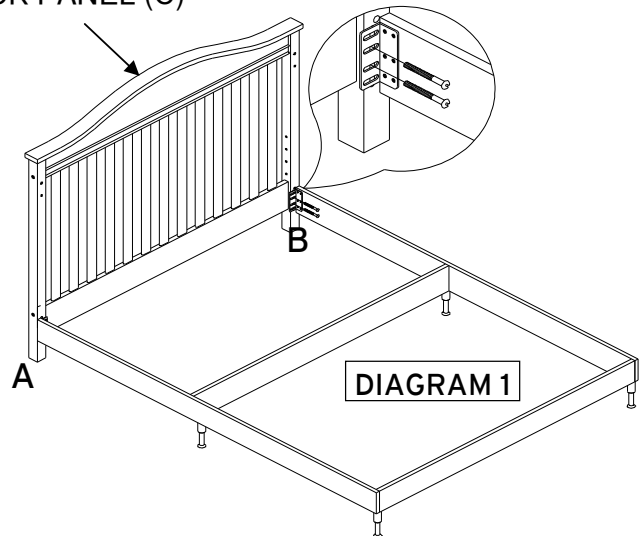

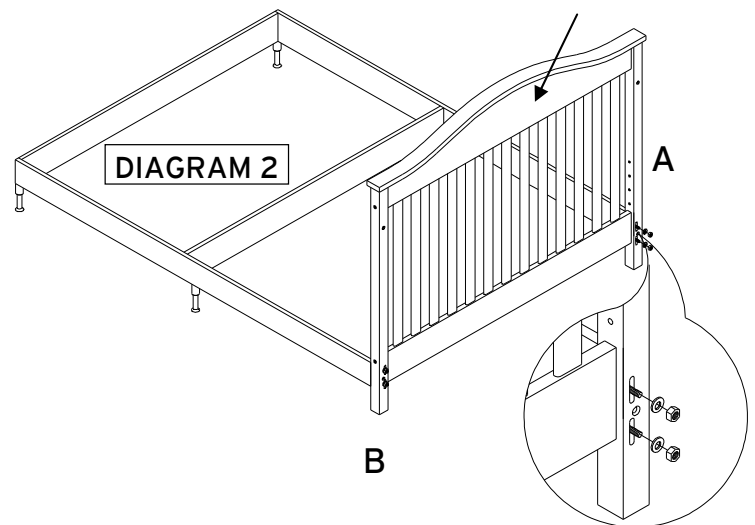
STEP 1: Attach the full size conversion rails (not included) to the left and right back posts (A & B) of the headboard.

STEP 2: Fasten the bolts with washers and nuts (not included).
