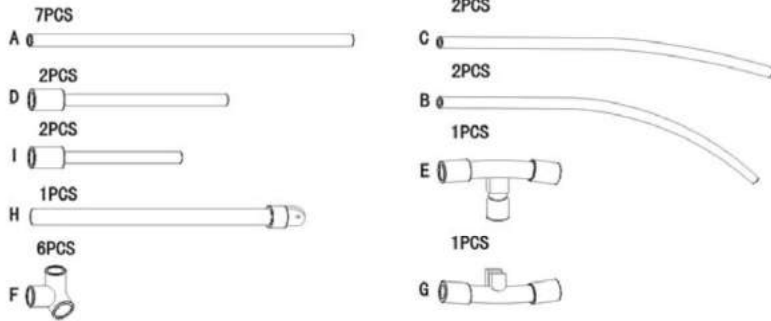
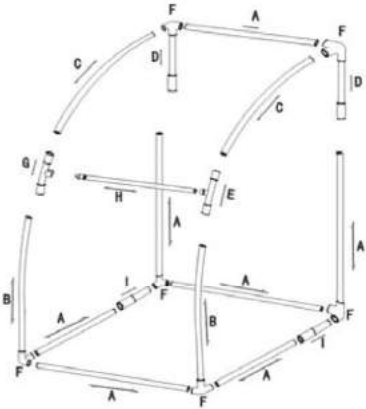


FRAME ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

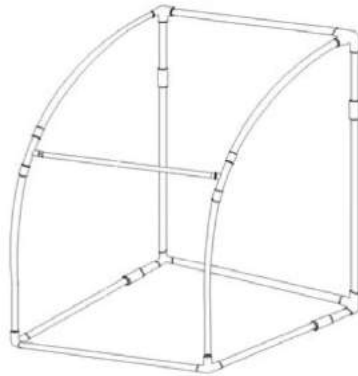
★ Fittings

★ ② The completed frame



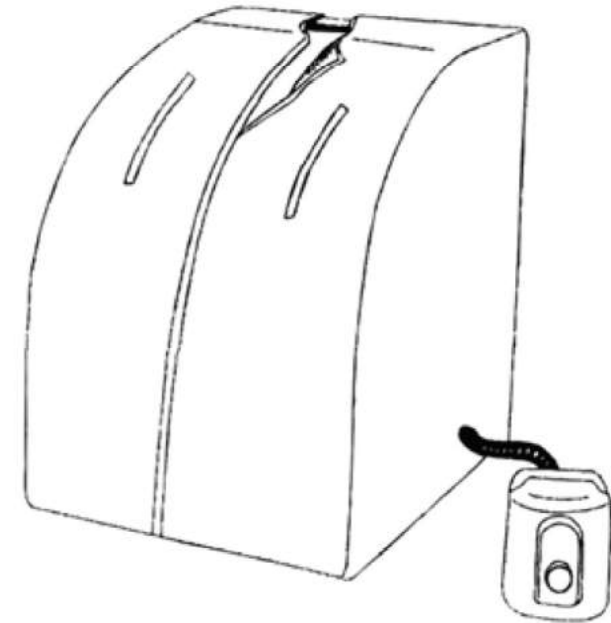

CAUTION: Please adjust the steam pipe so that it is pointing in a safe direction away from your body before using the sauna.

Precautions

- Before using this appliance, please read this manually carefully and keep it for future use.
- Please use care as hot steam is produced and can cause burns.
- Please keep children away from the steamer during operation and after using it while it cools down.
- Be sure to set up the steamer in an area where you can safely enter the tent and where you can access the steamer.
- Use care when entering/exiting the steam sauna while the steamer is on.
- Place the chair facing the zippered entrance for easy access.
- The steamer connection tube should be properly secured before you turn on the steamer.
- Please adjust where the steam enters the tent, the Y splitter should be facing away from you before you start the steamer.
- The steam can burn you if you are too close to the steam port.
- The floor of the sauna will become wet, please use caution when standing or sitting down.
- Do not touch the steamer with the wet hands or feet when it is plugged in to the wall.
- Do not place the steamer in any water or in any liquid with a chemical detergent.
- After use, wipe away the moisture with a soft dry cloth, this will help keep it clean while being able to extend the life of the steamer.
- Please unplug the steamer when it is not in use.

This high quality portable steam sauna with exclusive beneficial features, a great value and can be used in the privacy of your home apartment or any safe environment.

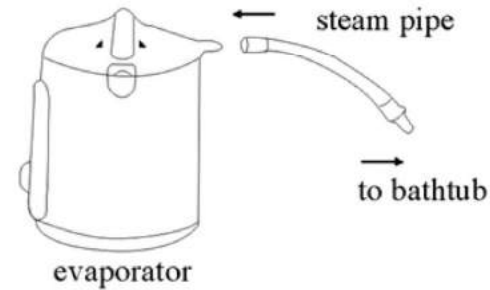
Steam is water in a gas form, this happens when water boils at 160-212°F (71-100°C).The steam is very hot to touch and can burn you, please use care when entering/exiting the sauna while the steamer is on.

Directions for use :

1. Assemble the frame as directed in the diagrams attached, then place the over the frame, connect steam pipe to the evaporator.



2. Fill the evaporator compartment with water up to the maximum water level. You can add a few drops of aromatherapy oils at this point.
3. Connect the evaporator's power plug into a wall outlet or surge protector. Set the time to 30 minutes or longer. Please be sure to adjust the steam pipe so that it is pointing in a safe direction away from your body.
4. The evaporator will start producing sufficient steam within 15 minutes. You can now adjust the length of the timer to your desire.
5. Place a suitable non-upholstered chair inside the sauna, sit down and enjoy your steam sauna.
6. After use always wipe the inside of the cover with a dry cloth, never put away damp.

CAUTION

- Do not immerse the evaporator in water.
- Pregnant women or persons with poor health should consult their physician before using any sauna.

Steam Sauna Visual Guide

Please use this guide with the manual that is included.

1. Take the unassembled tent out of the package. Choose a flat open space to set up your steam sauna.

2. The most efficient way to set up the steam sauna would be to build the base first and place inside the unzipped sauna tent.

3. Continue to build layer by layer using the manual for guidance.

4. Once you complete the frame it should look like the following.

5. You should release the support crossbar before you start to place the tent over the frame.

6. You will start with one side by pulling the tent over the corner. The sides of the frame may bend inwards to make it easier to pull the tent over the frame.

7. After you completed one side you will then follow step six for the other side.

8. As soon as you have both sides of the tent covering the frame go ahead and zip the back of the tent up first.

IMPORTANT notes:

Parts labeled G & E should have the smaller connectors attached. The larger ones you will use when building the base.



Please be sure the Y splitter for the steam is pointing in a safe direction before you start the steamer.
