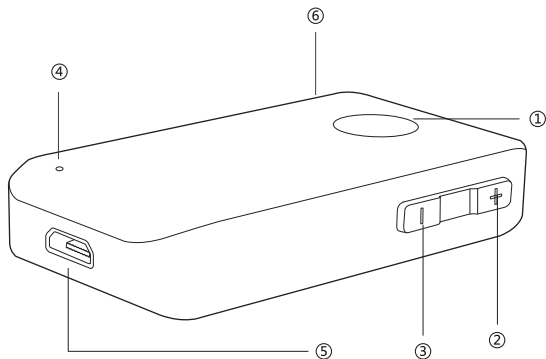

How to Use

1. Charging

- 1) Connect the charging port with any USB charging adapter or active computer USB port.
- 2) Charging will start automatically with the LED indicator turning green.
- 3) The receiver is fully charged when the LED indicator turns off.

Note: Charge the receiver at least once every 6 months when not using for a long time.

2. Pairing

- 1) Make sure the receiver and your Bluetooth® device are next to each other (within 3 feet / 1 meter).
- 2) The first time you use the receiver, press and hold the Power Button until the LED indicator flashes red
- 3) Activate Bluetooth® on your phone and search for the nearby Bluetooth® connections.
Find "Boltune BT-BR001" in the search results. Tap on the name to connect. Once connected, the LED indicator will flash blue.

Note: The Bluetooth® receiver can remember previously paired devices.

Button Control

Function	Operation
Power on / off	Press and hold the Power Button until the LED Indicator flashes / turns off
Play / Pause / Answer / Hang up phone call	Press the Power Button once
Reject phone calls	Press and hold the Power Button for 2 seconds
Redial	Press the Power Button twice
Volume + / -	Press and hold the Volume + / - Button
Previous / Next Track	Press the Volume + / - Button
