## Quick Start

STEP 1



Remove filter's red tape seal.

STEP 2



Remove door and firmly insert filter. Close door.

STEP 3



Fill soap tank up to the arrow on the soap reservoir.

STEP 4



Tightly attach male connector to the device. Tightly attach female connector to the hose. Snap male and female connector together for use.

STEP 5



Turn on water at the spigot and then grab your mitt and go!

## Usage Instructions

### MR. CLEAN WASH

**WASH IN SECTIONS and in the shade.**

Use jet-spray before soaping the car. Wet wash mitt with soap spray before washing each section.



Start by setting dial to RINSE and wet car.



For extra help with tough dirt & grime, use the JET-ACTION SPRAY setting.



Set dial to SOAP and spray car. Soap car with wash mitt.



RINSE again to eliminate all suds.

### MR. CLEAN AUTODRY



Set dial to Mr. Clean AUTODRY. Spray entire car, starting at the top.

Stay within 30 cm/1 foot of car while spraying back and forth until regular rinse water has been rinsed away. Watch your ride dry spot-free with ZERO HAND-DRYING!

If through accidental misuse, there is residue or water marks on your ride after it dries, immediately re-clean that area.

## Wash Mitt



**Mr. Clean AutoDry Wash Mitt**

band. Safe on your car finish.

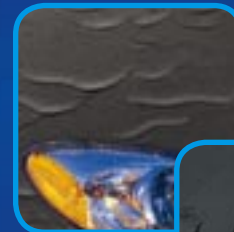


## Quick Tips

### Keep your ride spotless:

- Wash your car in the shade and in sections.
- Spray soap on your mitt as well as your car before you scrub each section.
- Rinse out wash mitt with rinse spray as needed during the process to remove dirt particles.
- Do not let soap dry on to your car! If that happens, re-wash that area and follow-up with the filter spray.
- Don't forget to spray the side mirrors with Mr. Clean AutoDry Filter Spray.

## Storage Case

Mr. Clean AutoDry Pro-Series Case is not an ordinary storage case. Yes, it has the usual benefits of a case, like organization and protection of your gear, but adds a few unique features.

### CREATIVE DRAINAGE SYSTEM

Store your gear as soon as you are done! Case will ventilate and drain so that your gear dries out and stays clean.

**COMPACT DESIGN** so that the case travels with you. Easily fits in your trunk so that there are no excuses for a dirty car. You can wash your car wherever there is a hose!



## Easy Clean-Up

### DEVICE

1. Turn off water at the spigot, spray out remaining water. Turn off device. Unclick device from the hose. Simply pull down on female connector piece and pull device out.
2. Turn device on and let water run out of the male connector. Turn device back off.
3. Place device in organizing carry case.

### MITT

Clean-up mitt by rinsing it out with water so that you do not have dirt left in your mitt. For a thorough clean, try washing your mitt in the washing machine with some Tide®.



### CASE

Store upright in your garage or any area where it is OK for any drainage to leak out from your wet gear.

If you do not store the case upright, you may experience soap leakage from the device.

## Mr. Clean AutoDry Soap

### What is the purpose of the soap?

Mr. Clean AutoDry Soap is designed to clean your ride with our unique Dry-Rinse Polymer. Don't be confused by the fact that Mr. Clean AutoDry Soap makes water spread out in a sheet on your car surface rather than bead up. Mr. Clean AutoDry Soap contains a polymer, the Dry-Rinse Polymer, that temporarily lays on top of your ride (even on top of your wax), making the car surface hydrophilic. This sheeting effect is important because it helps displace the tap water (and spot-forming ingredients in water) from the car's surface with deionized water during the final AutoDry Filter rinse.

### Is the soap safe for my vehicle?

Mr. Clean AutoDry Soap is formulated with one of the mildest cleaning agents commercially available.

Mr. Clean AutoDry Soap is specially designed for safe use on your car finish and will not strip wax.



## Refill Filter Education

## Frequently Asked Questions

### Where can I buy Mr. Clean AutoDry and refills?

You can find Mr. Clean AutoDry Soap and Mr. Clean AutoDry Filter refills wherever you purchased your Starter Kit or in the car wash section of most stores.

**Why wash my car in sections?** It helps you remember to rinse the soap off frequently so it doesn't dry on your car. It's especially important to do on sunny, hot days. It always helps you make sure you're washing the car thoroughly.

**Why does my sponge seem dirtier than normal?** Mr. Clean AutoDry lifts dirt away from your car and pulls it into your mitt/sponge. Therefore, it is

a good idea to rinse your mitt/sponge with the rinse setting in-between washing different sections and then soap up the mitt/sponge again before starting a new section.

**What are those bead-like things dancing across my car?** These are small beads of deionized rinse water. We call them purified microbeads.

### Why doesn't the water bead up after I rinse?

The sheeting action of the Dry-Rinse Polymer™ works with the Mr. Clean AutoDry Filter so that a thin layer of deionized water is left on the car's surface (which will quickly evaporate) leaving your

car spot free. Next time it rains, the beads will be back—and you get to wash again!

**Does it leave a film behind? Does it affect the polish or the wax?** Mr. Clean AutoDry doesn't leave behind a film, just a temporary, thin layer of the Dry-Rinse Polymer molecules that are replenished each time the car gets washed. These do not strip the wax, or harm the paint or clearcoat in any way.

**Can I use this on other vehicles?** Yes. The Mr. Clean AutoDry Carwash will clean lots of other vehicles. Try it on motorcycles, RVs, and boats. It also works on the windows of your home.

**What is the pH of Mr. Clean AutoDry Carwash Soap?** Fasten your seat belts, here comes a light-speed review of high school chemistry. On a scale of 0 to 14, pH measures the hydrogen ions floating in a substance. If the pH is less than 7, the solution is acidic; if it's greater than 7, it's basic or alkaline. Pure water has a neutral pH of 7.0. Orange juice (3.0 pH), beer (4.5 pH), and unpolluted rainwater (6.2 pH) are acidic, while baking soda (8.2 pH) and household bleach (11 pH) are alkaline. In its undiluted form, Mr. Clean AutoDry Carwash Soap is slightly acidic, with a pH of ~5. But when it's diluted as directed, its pH bracket is neutral (pH 6 to 8 depending on the water used to dilute the soap). After the soap is rinsed away with tap

water, the Mr. Clean AutoDry Filter comes in. It deionizes the water and leaves you with a spotless car.

**Why do I still see water spots/residue on my car?** Make sure you're using the Mr. Clean AutoDry Soap and Filter everywhere on the vehicle and that the filter hasn't turned brown (the sign that it's used up). As with any car-washing process, make sure that you do not leave residue on your car. If you see something on your surface when your car has dried, simply re-wash that area and then follow-up with the filter spray for a spot-free result.

**Wow, I think I see rainbows in the drying water. Are those things for real?** Yes, those are rainbows. They're caused by prism effects on the leading edge of the water as the sheet of water dries. If you still see them after your car is dry, you've spent far too long in the sun.

**How many uses are in the Starter Kit Soap and Filter versus the Refill Soap and Filters?**

Mr. Clean AutoDry Starter Filter gives you 3 uses and Mr. Clean AutoDry Refill Filter gives you 10 uses on average size vehicles in average conditions. Mr. Clean AutoDry Starter and Refill Soap uses will vary on factors such as how much soap you like to use, how dirty your ride is, and the size of your car.

**What is the difference between the Mr. Clean AutoDry Filter and softening water?** Mr. Clean AutoDry Filter is actually de-ionizing the water! Most conventional water softeners remove calcium and magnesium ions by replacing them with sodium ions. Therefore, "softened" water contains sodium chloride, or salt, which leaves visible water spots on your car. Mr. Clean removes cations AND anions in the water like calcium, magnesium, sodium and chloride such that the water left behind does not leave a water spot.

**What do I do with all the time I used to spend drying my car by hand?** Water sports. Here's how it works: The first few times you use the Mr. Clean AutoDry Carwash, you'll spend some of your extra time watching your car dry. There's no greater satisfaction. Eventually, you'll use the time to wash another car or—better yet—your neighbors' boat. They'll loan you the boat in appreciation, and you'll be out fishing, sailing, skiing—see where this is going? Water sports.
