3. Do not connect the Thunderbolt cable and the USB cable simultaneously.
4. The SJM100/300/500 is pre-formatted for use with Mac OS. To use it with Windows, please reformat with NTFS.

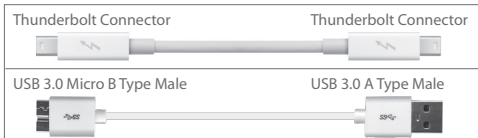

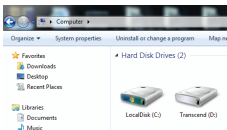
