

What is a regulated dangerous good?

A product is considered regulated if any of its components are classified as dangerous goods or substances or are otherwise regulated by one of the official organizations of transport (DOT, IATA, IMDG, ADR) or of product handling and storage (CLP, GHS).

Cosmetic products

Finished cosmetic products are exempted from the legislation requiring the provision of a 16 point Safety Data Sheet (SDS) [OSHA 29 CFR 1910.1200(b)(6)(vii)]. However, there are legal requirements under other legislations such as Health and Safety, Storage and Control of Substances Hazardous to Health and Transport of dangerous goods. Therefore any relevant information about the product that is necessary to enable appropriate risk management measures should be provided.

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
