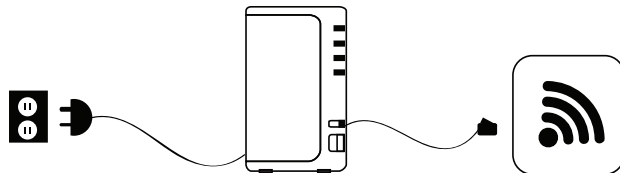
Hardware Setup



BeyondCloud Site

Step 1:

Connect the power supply for the NAS, and connect your NAS to your router or switch with the included network cable. Power on the NAS. When the system is ready, the blue power LED will turn solid and the NAS will beep.



Step 2:

Open your web browser and go to <http://find.synology.com> to connect to your NAS.

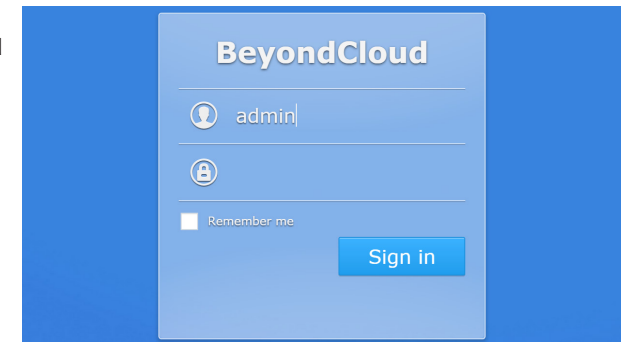


Step 3:

Once connected, login as **'admin'** and leave the password field empty. Then follow the configuration wizard.

Password: *leave blank*

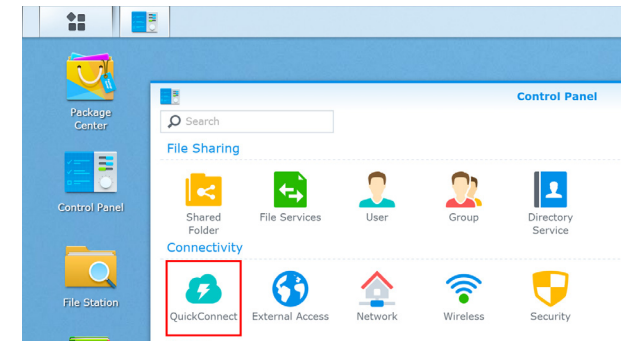


Step 4:

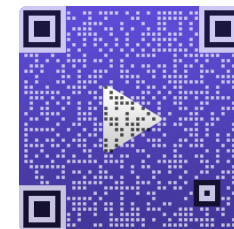
Once the configuration wizard is complete, familiarize yourself with the DSM. Then create a QuickConnect ID in the DSM Control Panel.
