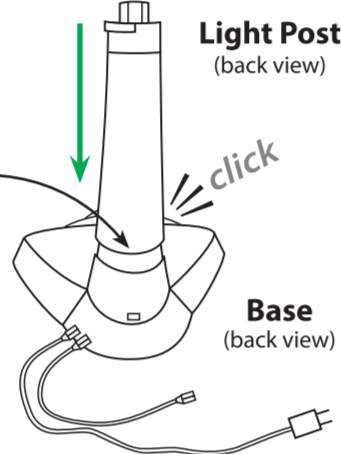

5 Easy Steps

To Get Your AeroGarden Up and Growing

1 Insert Light Post into Base

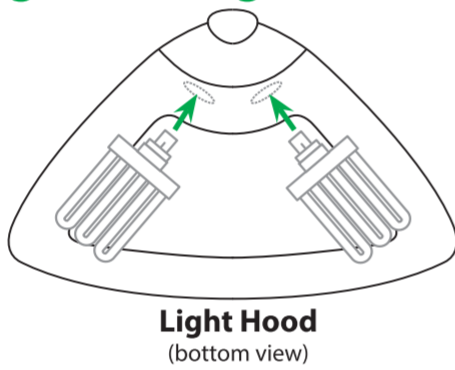
Push Light Post straight down until you hear a "click."



2 Install CFL Grow Lights into Light Hood
(If you have LED Grow Lights, skip this step)

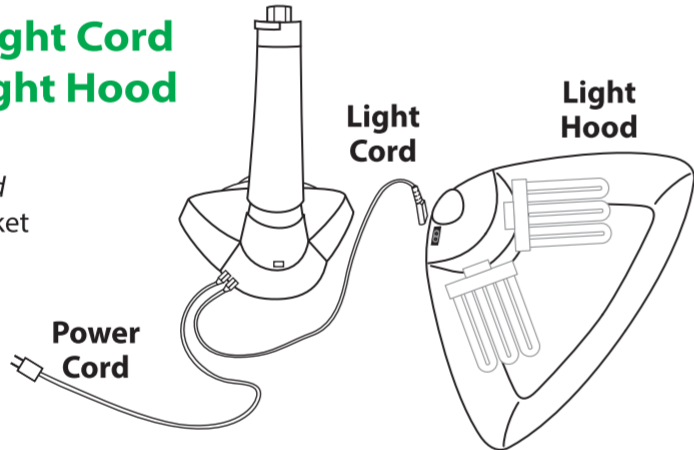
Push CFL Grow Lights straight into socket inside Light Hood

DO NOT TWIST LIGHT!



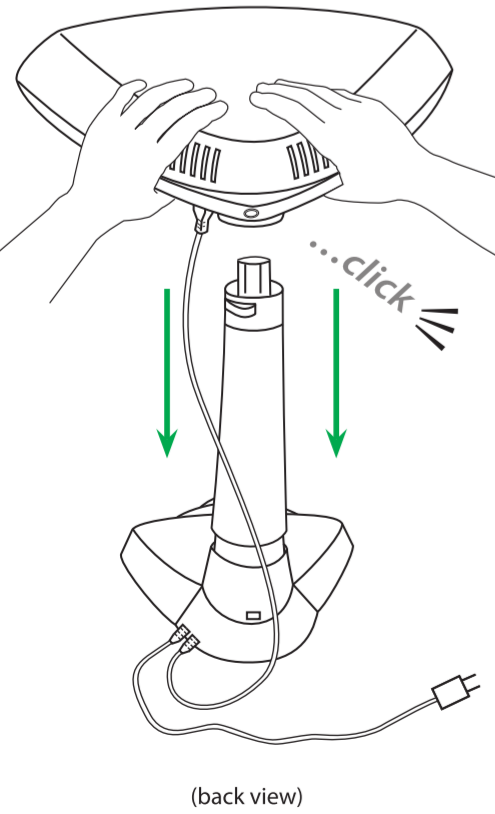
3 Plug Light Cord into Light Hood

Push Light Cord firmly into socket in Light Hood



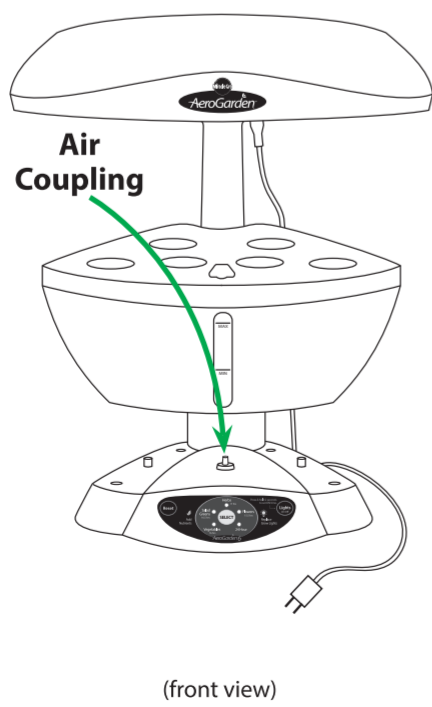
4 Place Light Hood on Light Post

Center hands over Light Post and push Light Hood down until you hear a "click."



5 Set Bowl into Base

Check to be sure that Bowl is securely seated on Air Coupling in Base.

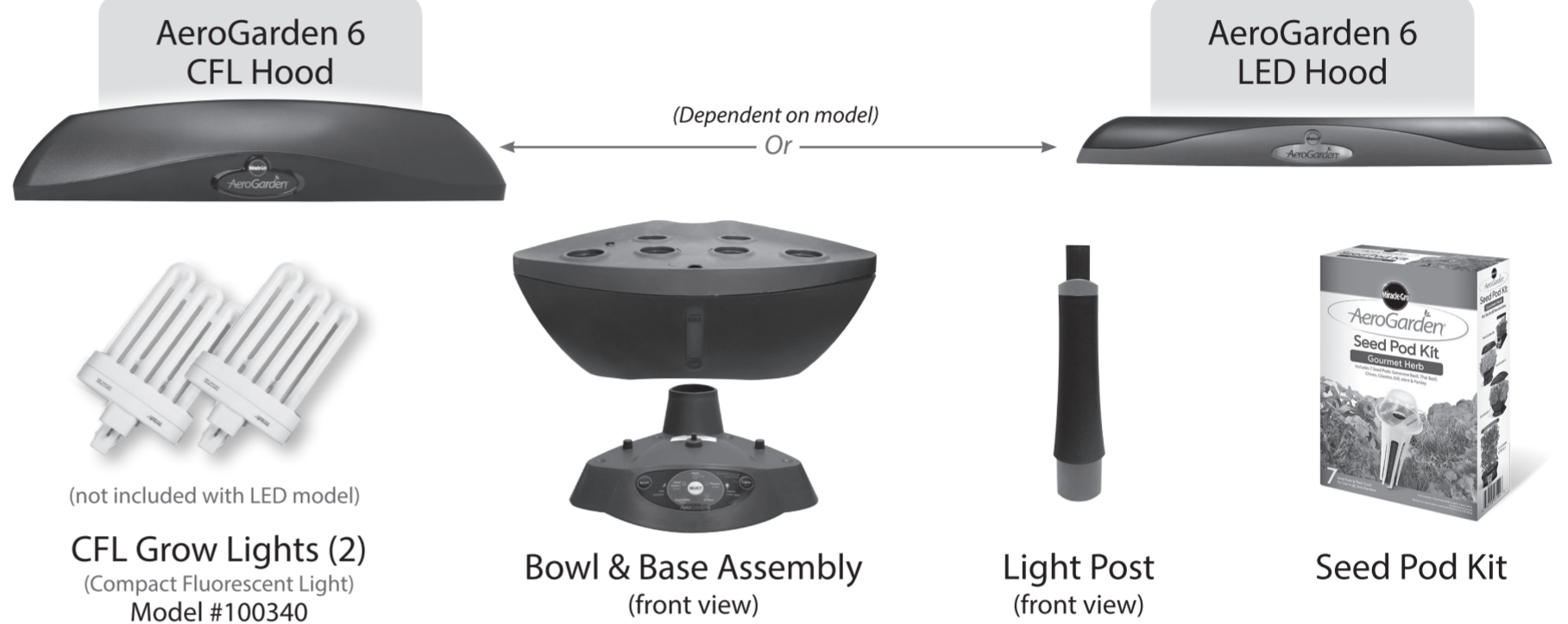
When using this AeroGarden electrical furnishing, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following: **Read all instructions before using this AeroGarden furnishing. SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS**

1. To reduce the risk of electric shock, the AeroGarden has a specific plug. Do not change the plug in any way.
2. Always unplug the AeroGarden from electrical outlet before cleaning or changing Grow Lights (light bulbs).
3. Unplug AeroGarden from outlet before putting on or taking off parts.
4. Close supervision is necessary when an AeroGarden is used by or near children, invalids, or disabled persons.
5. Use AeroGarden only for its intended use as described in the instructions. Do not use attachments not recommended by manufacturer.
6. Never operate AeroGarden if it has a damaged cord or plug, if it is not working properly, if it has been dropped and damaged, or if it has been dropped in water. If any of these conditions occur/exist, contact www.AeroGardenSupport.com or your country's local distributor for instructions.
7. Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
8. Never operate furnishing with air openings blocked. Keep air openings free of lint, hair, and the like.
9. Never drop or insert any object into any electrical openings.
10. Do not use outdoors.

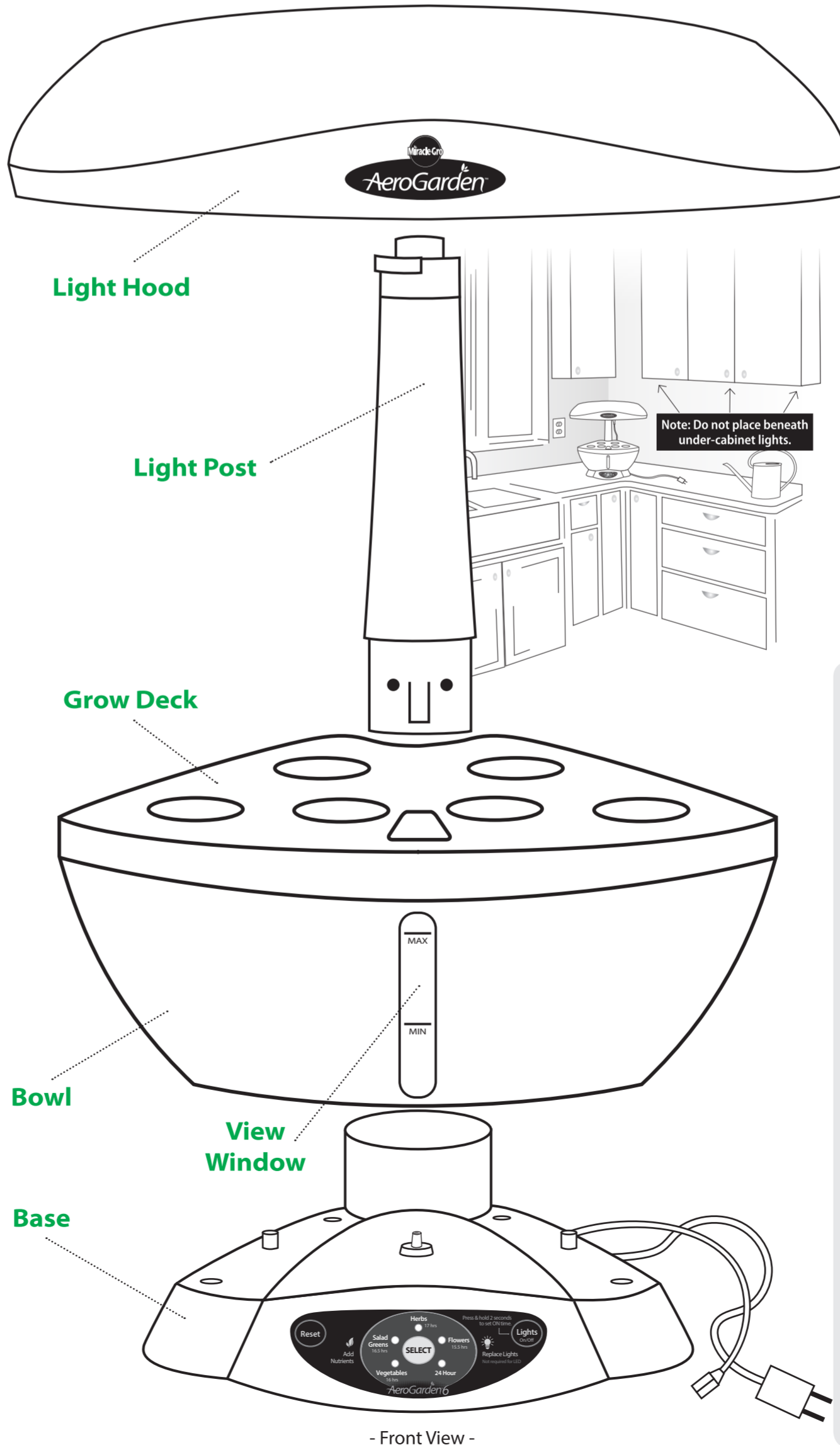
11. Do not operate where aerosol (spray) products are being used or where oxygen is being administered.
12. Do not touch moving parts or hot parts such as pumps, Grow Lights, reflective surfaces, and the like.
13. To disconnect, remove plug from outlet.
14. Do not place or submerge base, cord, plug, or Light Hood in water or other liquid to clean it.
15. Do not allow water to contact hot Grow Lights.
16. Use only approved and supplied parts and accessories. Use only AeroGarden brand Grow Lights with this AeroGarden model. Use of any other kind of accessory is not recommended. Replacement parts can be ordered from www.AeroGarden.com
17. Do not use AeroGarden for other than intended purpose.
18. This product is intended for household and residential use only. This product is not approved for commercial applications.
19. If supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by manufacturer, its service agent, or similarly qualified technician in order to avoid a hazard.
20. Electrical wiring must be in accordance with local regulations.

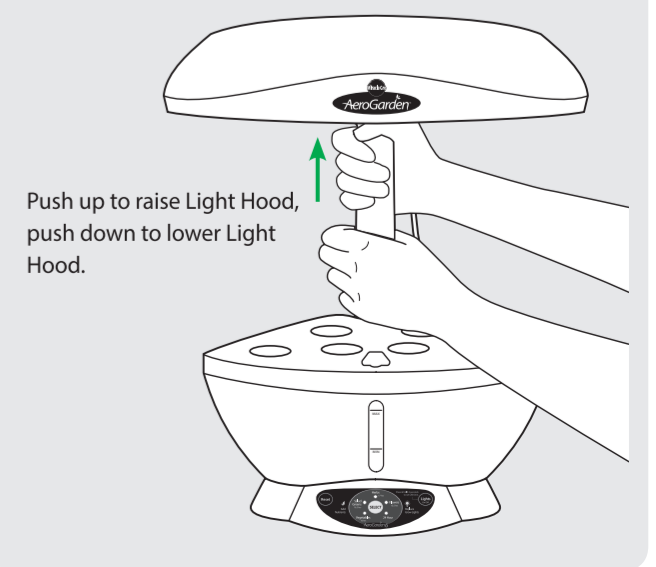
Place Your Garden...

- On a sturdy, water-tolerant surface
- Under a space that allows 22" (56cm) clearance for the full height of raised lamp
- Near a standard electrical outlet, per local regulations
- In a 65-80°F (16-26°C) environment (optimal)
- Away from reach of children or pets
- Away from direct sources of heat (e.g., stove, furnace vents) or cold (e.g., window drafts, A/C vents)
- AeroGardens do not need additional light or a sunny window. In fact, too much direct sunlight can overheat your plants

How to Raise and Lower the Light Hood

To raise the Light Hood, push in the lever on the back of the Light Post with one hand, and push up on the Light Post the with other hand. Push down on the Light Post to lower.

When planting a new Seed Pod Kit, the Light Hood should be set to the lowest possible position. For instructions and tips about when to raise (or not to raise) the Light Hood, refer to Gardening Tips (on flip side) and/or Seed Pod Kit Instruction booklet included with each seed kit.

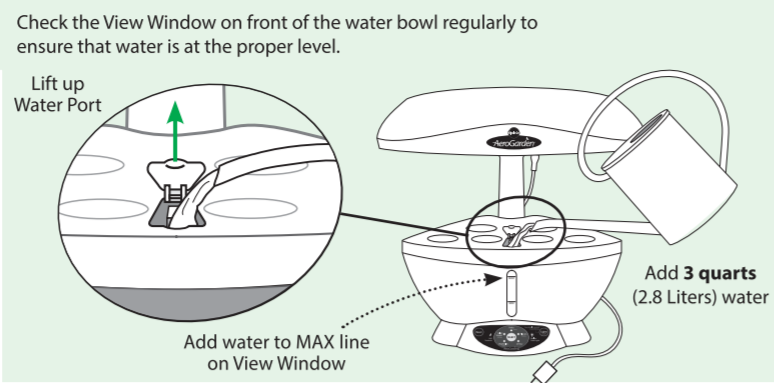

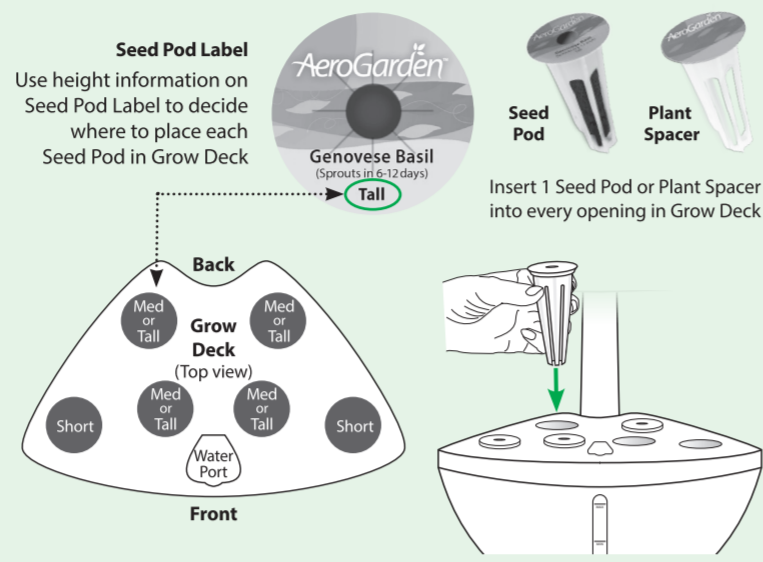
1. Add Water

- Add water to Bowl to 'MAX' line on View Window on Bowl. For best results, add water frequently to keep level topped up to 'MAX' line.
- Use room temperature tap water or bottled distilled water.
- Do not use well water which can upset the nutrient balance, or softened water, which contains levels of sodium usually harmful to plants.



2. Add Seed Pods

- Insert Seed Pods into openings in Grow Deck.
- Seed Pod Labels often identify plant height to assist with placement. Look for height noted on Labels.
- Plants grow best and look best if medium or tall plants are in back and front center openings, and short plants are in front side openings (see diagram).
- Seed Pod Kits for Tomatoes and Peppers often include both Seed Pods and Plant Spacers. Plant Spacers allow your Tomato/Pepper plants ample room to grow.
- Do not remove Labels from Seed Pods. The labels identify the plant type and plant height, show the germination time, and inhibit algae growth.



3. Add Grow Domes

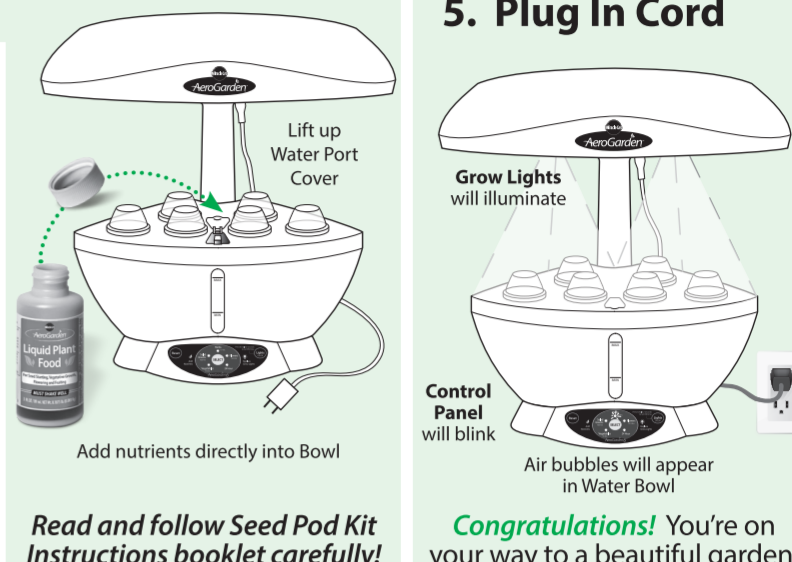
- Place a Grow Dome over each Seed Pod.
- Grow Domes rest on Seed Pods and may not 'snap' into place. Also, it is not necessary for Grow Domes to cover any Plant Spacers in your AeroGarden.
- Leave Grow Domes on the Seed Pods until plants have sprouted and their leaves nearly touch the domes.
- Once removed, Grow Domes may be reused/recycled.



4. Add Nutrients

- Nutrient instructions are printed on the packaging, as well as in the Seed Pod Kit Instructions booklet. Read and follow the instructions carefully!
- Use only the recommended amount of Liquid Nutrient.
- Add nutrient directly into Bowl when first planting your Seed Pod Kit, and when the 'Add Nutrient' reminder activates (every 2 weeks).
- Do not overfeed! More isn't better. Too much nutrient may be harmful to your plants.

Nutrient Feeding Tip: Always top off water level when adding Liquid Nutrients. For best results, top off the water level in your garden regularly.



Control Panel Settings

Select Plant Type

Press the SELECT button until you reach the type of plants you are growing: Vegetables, Salad Greens, Herbs, or Flowers. Your AeroGarden 6 Grow Lights will automatically turn on and off at pre-programmed intervals according to the plant type selected. The number of hours that the Grow Lights remain ON is listed beneath each plant type on the control panel. Lights turn off automatically at the end of the light cycle. Seedlings love light! You can set the light cycle to 24 hours for the first month to give seedlings the best possible start.

Add Nutrients

When "Add Nutrient" light blinks (every 2 weeks), add Liquid Nutrients into the Bowl and top up the water level to "Fill To Here." Press and release the "Reset" button to restart nutrient timer and turn off the blinking light.

Replace Grow Lights

When "Replace Grow Lights" light blinks (after 6 months of use), it is time to replace both CFL Grow Lights (continue reading for LED instructions). You may want to turn off Lights for a few minutes to allow them to cool. Once replaced, press and release "Reset" button to restart Grow Light timer and turn off the blinking light. Additional Grow Lights can be ordered at www.Aerogarden.com.



For LED version, simply press and release 'Reset' button to turn off reminder light. You do not need to replace your LED Grow Lights unless individual diodes start to fail. Diodes have a 2 - 5 year life span.

Lights On/Off

Use to occasionally override built-in light timer. Once pushed, lights will stay on/off until the next time built-in light timer is set to go on/off. This will not affect the timing of your light cycle and occasional use of this feature will not harm your plants.

Note: In case of an electrical power outage, your AeroGarden has a backup memory system that stores timers for nutrients and Grow Light replacement. You may need to reset your Grow Light timer by following the "Personalize Your Light Timer" instructions.

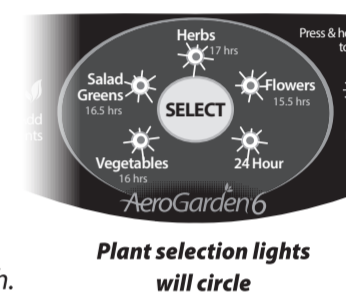
How to Personalize Your Light Timer (Optional)

When you plug in your AeroGarden for the first time, the Grow Lights will come on, and they will continue to come on at this same time every day. If you are satisfied with the light timer, you do not need to make any changes. If you would like to change the time of day when the lights come on, follow this simple step:

At the exact time of day when you want the lights to come ON:

- Press and hold the Lights button for about 2 seconds, then release. Plant selection lights will turn on/off in a circular pattern to confirm the change has been made. Grow Lights are now set to come ON at this time each day.

Note: You can reset your timer as often as you wish.



An Important Note About Lights

Your AeroGarden 6 has a built-in timer for Grow Lights that automatically provides your plants with "sunlight" (about 16 hours) and "night" (about 8 hours). As long as your plants get this amount of light, it does not matter what time the lights are off. Many people find it most convenient to have the lights go on in the morning and off at night, to match their own personal wake and sleep schedule.

Gardening Tips for Maximum Harvests

PLANTING

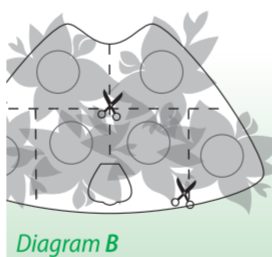
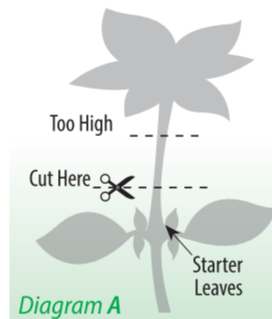
- ▶ Many Seed Pods are labeled for height. Gardens grow and look their best when tall plants are placed in back openings, and short plants in front openings. If plants are all the same size, like Salad Greens, they can be planted anywhere.
- ▶ Do not remove Labels from Seed Pods. The labels identify the plant type and plant height, show the germination time, and inhibit algae growth.
- ▶ Grow Domes help regulate moisture and temperature for optimal germination. Leave them on until plants are nearly touching the domes.
- ▶ Seed Pod Kits for large plants like Tomatoes and Peppers often receive fewer than 7 Pods to compensate for the large plant size.

GERMINATION

- ▶ Some seeds germinate in less than 24 hours. Some take 24 days or more. Most labels give an estimate of how long your seeds will take to germinate but many factors impact germination.
- ▶ As a rule of thumb, if you are comfortable, so are your plants. However, plants are impacted by temperature. Cold weather plants like Salad Greens germinate better in cooler temperatures. Heat lovers like Tomatoes and Peppers will germinate faster in warmer temperatures (above 70°F). But don't sweat it! While some may take a bit more time, your seeds will germinate.
- ▶ If you are growing your own seeds, plant 5-6 seeds per pod and check the seed packet for information regarding temperature and days to germination.

PRUNING

- ▶ Prune your plants, don't raise your lights! You will achieve more compact, beautiful growth and bigger harvests if you prune to keep the lights closer to all plants in your garden.
- ▶ Fast growing plants (like Basil) make gardeners want to raise the lights too soon. Resist! Pruning the plants just above a new leaf set (Diagram A) and leaving the lights down low will ensure that slow-growing and low-growing plants get all the light they need to flourish.
- ▶ Prune often to maintain a healthy garden, but never take more than 1/3 of each individual plant at a time.
- ▶ Plants compete for light. Left unattended, more aggressive growers can actually block enough light to suppress growth of their slower growing neighbors, which eventually can die off due to lack of light. Spreading leaves must be trimmed (Diagram B) to make sure that all plants get enough light to thrive and produce big yields.
- ▶ Not pruning is the number one gardening mistake made by new AeroGardeners! Prune early and prune often — and enjoy your first small harvests! There will be plenty more to come.
- ▶ Finally, pruning = harvesting. Each time you prune you get to enjoy fresh-picked herbs in a salad, soup, on pizza or a sandwich. And a full, bushy garden looks much better than one spindly, giant plant surrounded by straggly, light-starved neighbors. Pruning also releases a wonderful scent. So prune!



WATER

- ▶ Plants grown in the AeroGarden are designed to thrive with most municipal tap water. If your water is especially hard, improved results can be seen with distilled water or reverse osmosis water, but this is not needed in most cases.
- ▶ Do not use well water or softened water. Most well water contains a high amount of dissolved solids that upset the balance of our nutrients, and softened water adds sodium. This can result in plants suddenly browning, or just not growing well.
- ▶ Best results are achieved by topping up water regularly and keeping water level near the MAX line on the View Window.

LIGHTS

- ▶ Plants love light! Always keep your Grow Lights as close to your plants as possible. As they mature, plants should be 1-2 inches below Grow Lights.
- ▶ Always check to see if you can prune plants instead of raising the lights. After pruning, lower your lights back down if possible.
- ▶ You can set the light cycle to 24 hours for the first month to give seedlings the best possible start.
- ▶ For best growth, we recommend replacing CFL Grow Lights every 6 months, as continual use can reduce their growing power.
- ▶ You do not need to replace your LED lights unless individual diodes start to fail. Diodes have a 2-5 year life span.

NUTRIENTS

- ▶ Typically, your plants will need nutrients every 2 weeks.
- ▶ Follow instructions for feeding amounts printed on the Liquid Nutrient packaging.
- ▶ Add nutrients directly into water bowl.
- ▶ More isn't better. Resist the temptation to add "just a little extra." Too much nutrient can hurt your plants.
- ▶ Nutrient requirements for Tomatoes and Peppers may change as

plants grow. Please refer to the Liquid Nutrient packaging for specific details.

- ▶ For best results, try a "Rinse and Refill" once a month when it's time to add nutrients. Simply empty all water from the bowl, add fresh water and nutrients and reset the nutrient timer. This balances the nutrients, delivering an instant 'pick up' to plants.

POLLINATING

Because most people don't have bees in their home, you will need to start pollinating your fruiting plants (tomatoes, peppers, strawberries, etc.) once they begin to flower (approximately 4 - 6 weeks after planting). To pollinate, use one or more of the following methods:

- ▶ Place an open hand inside plant branches and gently move your hand back and forth to shake the plant and spread the pollen.
- ▶ Place a fan near your plants and the moving air will pollinate your plants.
- ▶ Touch the main stem of the plants with an electric toothbrush and allow the vibration to spread the pollen.

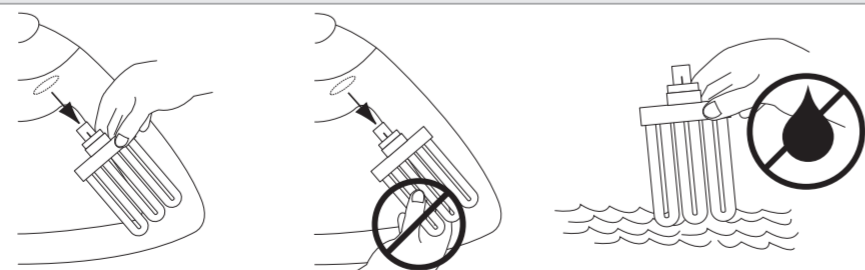
HARVESTING

- ▶ Many first-time growers are hesitant to harvest. Don't be! Most gardens will produce more, for a longer period, with frequent harvests. You almost can't begin to harvest (prune) early enough.
- ▶ AeroGardens work best with a harvesting method called "cut and come again." Simply put, you enjoy frequent small harvests and then watch as the plants rapidly regrow - ready for harvest again and again.
- ▶ Enjoy smaller harvests for the first month or two until plants mature and larger harvests are available.
- ▶ Harvest often to maintain a healthy garden, but never take more than 1/3 of each individual plant at a time.
- ▶ For Salad Greens, cut the top 2 inches off the entire garden, or harvest large leaves individually by cutting off at the base of the plant.

Do not immerse cord in water or other liquid, and unplug cord from outlet when not in use.

To reduce the risk of electric shock, this furnishing has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician to install the proper outlet. Do not change the plug in any way.
